## **MONTHLY DEVOTIONAL**

"Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you."

**Exodus 20:12** 

As Mother's Day and Father's Day come to a close this year, many of us are grateful we had the opportunity to treat our parents to breakfast in bed, stand by their side while they read a heartfelt card, or just accepted our phone call letting them know we were thinking of them while miles apart. It was special being able to show them they're appreciated for all that they are and for all that they do.

However, for many of us, these are challenging holidays. Many of us in our communities are estranged from our parents. Many of the people who raised us are still not able to accept us for who we are and the way that we have turned out. In the battle to get them to accept us as God made us, we have ultimately had to go our separate ways for emotional, mental and spiritual survival. We have had to trust God to deal with them about our design. God still is dealing with them and it is a process that can often take a long time. God has to work against years of misguided teachings from the Church, culture, and society's stereotypes and many are still so unwilling to be enlightened. I just want to encourage you by reminding you that it is a tremendously scary process for older people to learn new things; gain a fresh perspective and walk in new wisdom. I'd like to take this opportunity to comfort those of you who may be in this boat, with one of God's promises.
